- First point of contact for all SCM's should be the ETTA Regional Development Manager.
- Closing date (following County competitions) for entry to ESTTA Team (Zone) is 8th December. Closing date (following County competitions) for entry to ESTTA Individual Championships is 13th March.
- Boys with over 500 rating points and girls with over 250 rating points on the [ETTA Junior ratings list](#), current at the event closing date, are exempt from SSP rounds of individual competitions and may enter the County Schools' Individual event directly. School teams who have previously represented their county are exempt from SSP rounds of team competitions and may enter the County Schools' event directly.
- Table Tennis in terms of LTAD is an early specialisation sport. Targeting the above age groups and identifying young players who can link with local ETTA accredited clubs will help to drive increased participation in the sport.
